General Bursary

The banded General Bursary is available for full time students of all ages who meet the following criteria:

Low earnings under £25,000*

Income Support

Income based Job Seekers Allowance

Income-related Employment Support Allowance

Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

The guarantee element of state pension credit

Child Tax Credit—provided you have an annual income as

assessed by Revenue and Customs that does not exceed £25,000*

Universal Credit (replacing Income support, income-based

Job Seekers Allowance, income-related Employment and Support

Allowance and Child Tax Credits)

***Subject to the availability of funds**

Targeted Bursary

The Targeted Bursary is a fund of £1,200 per year for students who are in care, a care leaver, in receipt of income support, Universal Credit or disabled and in receipt of Employment and Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance. You can apply for this Bursary using the same application form as the General Bursary.



Other help

Free Meals—Are available to disadvantaged students at Carmel College (Government thresholds apply). If you have been eligible for free school meals, you are likely to be eligible for them at College. *For further information please look on the College website for guidance on eligibility.*

Transport— If you live over 3 miles from College and qualify for the General Bursary you will also receive the Transport Bursary.
